

How to Gain Admission to Delta View?



Access to funded beds is managed by the Fraser Health Authority Case Manager.

The B.C. Ministry of Health can subsidize the fee (per diem) for care at DVLEC if the client is financially eligible.

Contact **Fraser South Central Intake** by calling **604-953-4965** Monday to Friday from 8:00am-4:00pm and saying "Reception".

A Fraser Health Case Manager will refer you to someone who will conduct a financial assessment on your loved-one. If your loved-one is eligible, they will be placed on a funded bed wait list.

The wait list can range from 3-5 years and is operated under the First Available bed policy in a facility of choice.

You will have to rank your facility choices and accept the first available bed that opens in one of those facilities in order to take advantage of the funded bed.

Arrangements for Private Pay beds can be made through contacting the Admissions Assistant and DVLEC Administration directly.

What to Expect on Move-In Day

Admissions are arranged for 11:00am.

You will be greeted at reception and accompanied to your home by a nurse from the house as well as the admissions coordinator.

Important consent forms must be completed by the authorized family member on the day of admission. This will include the Degree of Intervention form. Please ask your nurse and admission coordinator for more information.

It will be important to bring at least 7 days worth of all clothing including under garments and non-skid shoes. Please ensure that clothing is seasonally-appropriate.

Feel free to bring a lounge chair of your own that does not swivel or have wheels and bring mementos and pictures for your room and your memory box.

We welcome one family member to be our lunch guest on move-in day. One complimentary meal ticket will be given to that family member and any other meal tickets can be purchased at Reception for \$7.00 each.

The building is open from 8:00am to 8:00pm but visiting hours are from 10:00am to 8:00pm.

Private Pay Bed Per Diem (on top of rent) - \$205.00 /day
Funded Bed Per Diem - calculated by Fraser Health.
Hip Protectors - \$89.00 per pair + delivery
Medications - Vary individually and are billed directly to family (not all medications are covered by Pharmacare)
Cable TV - Through Delta Cable, billed directly to family
Hair Dressing Services - Cost varies with service, billed to resident's trust fund.
