Delta View Life Enrichment Centre is a village of 8 specialized neighbourhoods built to enhance the care experience and meet the individual needs of every resident entrusted to our care.

Through the aging process and the progression of dementia or illness, the constellation of individual resident-clients' needs change over time. With those changes, the pressure of their home environment, on them, also changes.

This is part of the aging-in-place process. When this occurs, Delta View Administration will move residents internally within the 8 house village to the "Best Fit" house which most appropriately meets the care, cognitive and social needs of each resident as they age in place at Delta View.

ALPINE MEADOWS

Alpine Meadows is a 27 bed house. The beds are subdivided into 19 beds for long term residents, 6 beds for long term residents requiring various forms of dialysis and 2 beds purchased by the Worker's Compensation Board for rehabilitation of injured workers from across British Columbia.

The resident clients in Alpine Meadows are generally more independent with activities of daily living (ADL's) and are more cognitively and socially able.

The house staff provide a spectrum of levels of assistance with all activities of daily living (ADL's).

BAYCREST

Baycrest is a home for 26 residents comprising 22 single rooms and 2 shared rooms. The double rooms are reserved for resident clients who require more assistance and care.

Resident clients living in Baycrest may have a mild to moderate degree of cognitive impairment due to dementia and perhaps also be faced with physical or medical challenges.

The house staff provide a spectrum of levels of assistance with all activities of daily living (ADL's) though all Baycrest residents are actively encouraged to participate directly.

CASCADES

Cascades is a 26 bed home for resident clients who may suffer from some increased degree of cognitive impairment due to dementia & associated physical or medical illness.

The house focuses on supporting resident clients to maintain their current level of independence, focusing on what the resident can do for themselves rather than what is no longer a strength. The house staff provide a spectrum of levels of assistance with all activities of daily living (ADL's) though all Cascades residents are actively encouraged to participate.

DOROTHY'S MEADOWS

Dorothy's Meadows is a 27 bed home for resident clients who suffer from cognitive impairment due to dementia, associated physical or medical illness and behaviours. The house is cozy and homey without being over-stimulating.

The house focuses on supporting resident clients to maintain their current level of independence, focusing on what the resident can do for themselves rather than what is no longer a personal strength. The house staff provide a spectrum of levels of assistance with all activities of daily living (ADL's).



EAGLE POINT

Eagle Point is a 27 bed home for resident clients who suffer from cognitive impairment due to dementia, associated physical or medical illness and experience physical restriction or need for total care. The house is also home to a small community of South Asian, Indo-Canadian residents and prides itself on providing individualized care with cultural and linguistic sensitivity.

The house focuses on supporting resident clients to maintain their current level of independence, focusing on what the resident can do for themselves rather than what is no longer a personal strength.

FOREST GROVE

Forest Grove is a 26 bed home for resident clients who suffer from some degree of cognitive impairment due to dementia, associated physical or medical illness.

The house focuses on supporting resident clients to maintain their current level of independence, focusing on what the resident can do for themselves rather than what is no longer a personal strength.

The house staff provide a spectrum of levels of assistance with all activities of daily living (ADL's) though all Forest Grove residents are actively encouraged to participate.

GARDEN GROVE

Garden Grove is a 27 bed home, 12 beds largely dedicated to respite stays. Respite provides access to short-term residential services for families and care givers during vacations, illnesses or for personal stress-relief from the caregiving process. The house also has 15 long term resident beds.

The house is a busy one, with a wide spectrum of residents who are generally active and mobile but also hosts complex care. The house staff provide a spectrum of levels of assistance with all activities of daily living (ADL's) though all Garden Grove residents are actively encouraged to participate.

HEATHER POINT

Heather Point is a 27 bed home with 21 single rooms and 3 double-occupancy rooms. Resident clients in Heather Point suffer moderate to severe cognitive impairment and are generally immobile or require total care for all Activities of Daily Living (ADL's).

The house promotes security and comfort as well as sensory stimulation and enrichment.

The house focuses on supporting individualized resident clients needs and personal strengths.
