


Volunteer Programs & Activities

Volunteering at Delta View

What are the Requirements ?

In order to assess whether volunteering at Delta View is a right fit for you, we require all applicants to complete a Volunteer Application Form. You can pick up this form up at the Front Desk. You will be required to provide us with at least one reference check.

In compliance with Fraser Health Regulations, all volunteers are required to complete the following:

- A Valid Criminal Record Check
- A signed Confidentiality Agreement
- An Orientation, where you must demonstrate an understanding of Delta View's Safety Procedures and Infection Control Practices
- Parental Consent, if you are under the age of 14

Why do you want to Volunteer?

In order to ensure that your experience volunteering at Delta View is a positive one, we need to know *what your reason is for wanting to volunteer at Delta View.*

We also want to know what special skills and interests you have. There are many programs that you can help participate with, and we would like to make sure that we utilize your special skills and talents.

Volunteer Availability

There are a many opportunities to volunteer at Delta View and we are willing to work with your availability.

However, some programs and activities are scheduled at a specific day and time, so the programs and activities that you participate in, may depend on your availability.


At the end of each volunteer session, you are required to schedule an appointment for your next volunteer session. If you cannot make it to your next scheduled session, we ask that you provide us with the courtesy of providing us with as much notice as possible.

Requirements for Letters of References

If you require volunteer hours for entry into an educational program, or for school, you must provide us with this information during your application process and discuss this with the Volunteer Co-coordinator. This is to ensure that we are able to match you with the right programs and activities so that you can get the most out of your experience here at Delta View.



Unless otherwise arranged with the Volunteer Co-ordinator, references will be provided only after you have successfully completed 60 hours over a period of at least six months.

It is recommended that you volunteer a minimum of one hour per week, and a maximum of six hours per week.

If you require a reference letter, you will also be required to sit down for Check Ins with the Volunteer Co-ordinator at periods of 10 hours, 20 hours and 60 hours. The purpose of this process is to get feedback on your performance to ensure that Delta View is the right fit for you.
